



SST 'on site' services

Procedures in brief
Updated 29th August 2020

'On site' services will resume on Sunday 6th September. They will be shorter and socially distanced. This will require a number of changes to accommodate the guidelines.

The safety of everyone in the church service is paramount, so please remember that these are the conditions on which people attend:

- You must wear a face covering unless you are exempt due to a medical reason as set out by Government guidelines;
- Entry is by the church car park front door only. You will need to queue here until ushered in by a member of the Welcome Team;
- Hand sanitiser stations should be used upon entry and exit to the building;
- You will be asked to confirm your name and these records will be kept for 30 days;
- Toilets will be available, but we ask that you follow the instructions regarding cleaning before and after use;
- You will be given a seat number and led to that seat by the Welcome Team. You cannot sit where you normally would due to the restrictions;
- Everyone will exit via the fire escape door into the car park. The exit will be conducted in a staggered manner. This will be explained at the end of the service;
- Congregating in the car park is not allowed. Please respect social distancing both inside and outside of the building;
- Other instructions may be given on the day to ensure your safety.
